CATEGORIES

The competition is open to all students, academic scholars, faculties and recent passed out (0-3 years), who have innovative sustainable idea that they believe that will contribute towards 'Sustainable Development Goals'.

PRIZE DETAILS

Best 10 projects will be selected for the final round of competition. Best three ideas will get chance to **win Grand prize, second prize and third prize.**

- » Grand prize winners will gain international exposure, where they will have the opportunity to attend International technology fair.
- » Second prize winner will have prize money: 50,000 INR.
- » Third prize winner will have prize money: 25,000 INR.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Students and Academic scholars must be more than 18 years of age and enrolled in a full-time degree program of college/institute registered under state or central university. Students from Private or Deemed Universities may also apply. For Faculties, must be working as a faculty in a full-time degree program of college/institute registered under state or central university. Working in a Private or Deemed Universities may also apply. Recent pass-out students/alumnus (0-3 years) from



college or university from India, working on innovative idea/venture are eligible to apply for competition.

SUBMISSION PROCESS

Applicants must register from our official website: <u>www.inc2018.com</u>

Step 1: Go to the Home page of our website and click on Register now.

Step 2: You will redirect to the sign-up page for the competition.

Step 3: Fill out the details required in the form and click on submit (One individual can submit maximum 3 project proposal)

Step 4: You can update your application later on after submitting the application using your signup details.

HOW TO PREPARE A PROJECT PROPOSAL FILE:

Power Point Presentation (PPT) files should be MAXIMUN 50 MB. Recommended filename format: booking ID + first name Your project proposal must contain following information:

- ✓ An introduction that summarizes the proposal
- ✓ The problem you're tackling
- ✓ The solution you're proposing
- ✓ Details about project prototype/design
- ✓ Other relevant information which may include project achievements, website link, etc.....

SELECTION PROCESS

The projects/ideas submitted by participants will undergo number of stages to qualify for the final stage of competition at the .Inc competition. Various stages of selection process include,

Stage 1 – Application Submission

Projects/Ideas will be received through online application.

Stage 2 – Semi Final Round

From application pool, 10 applications will be shortlisted for semi-final round and will be informed via telephone/email.

Selected applicants will be called at Ahmedabad for semi-final round of presentation.

Stage 3 – Jury

The 10 entries that are deemed best are invited to the .Inc event.

10 minutes to present their project against the jury during the event on ______, 2019. (Event date will be announced on the INC website)

• Under to Incorporation Stage 4 – Winner Announcement

3 best projects will be selected for the Grand prize, Second prize and Third prize.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Participants projects will be evaluated based on 5 evaluation criteria described below:

- Innovation: How innovative is your project and what makes it better compared to existing alternatives?
- Sustainability: How does your project contribute to a more sustainable city/society?
- Feasibility: Is your project realistic and what is the readiness level to apply it?
- Market potential: How does the commercialization potential of your project look like?
- Team competence: Are you motivated and can you or your team make this idea happen for real, grow and expand?

Please consider that the jury isn't familiar with your innovative idea/project field. Do make sure while you submit your project that you fulfil all the evaluation criteria to get selected.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

.Inc Competition is open to all students, academic scholars, faculties and recent passed out. Anyone over 18 years of age can enter the competition. All participants must fulfil all the eligibility criteria. By registering and entering the Competition you hereby accept these Terms and Conditions.

A) PARTICIPATING CONDITIONS

- » A Participant needs to fill out a form that will be available on the website (www.inc2018.com).
- » It is the Participants' responsibility to ensure that their personal details (name, address, date of birth, email id, ID Proof) are always updated and accurate.
- » Any correspondence regarding the Contest shall be sent to the Participants at the e-mail address provided by them in the Entries.
- The Participant shall be required to fill out a detailed form available on the website (www.inc2018.com) wherein he/she will have to answer all the questions in the manner specified.
- » Upon receipt of Entries, the Organisers & Sponsors shall in their sole discretion evaluate the same and pick the top 10 Entries ("Participants") who will then be part of final round of .Inc Idea Competition.
- » Participants must have 1 to 3 members in the project team. It is allowed to submit more than one submission per team. One or more submissions may be submitted individually.
- » Participants can submit maximum 3 (three) projects per team.
- » All entries must be the original work of the participant and must not infringe the rights of any other party.

D) PRIZES

Prize will not be paid in cash, rather travel tickets, logging and boarding worth ------ will be sponsored. Dates of travel will be decided (Summer-March-April 2019). There are no cash alternatives available for grand winner.
- » Second and third prize winner will be paid in cash/cheque.

E) JUDGING CONDITIONS

- » Submitted entries will be judged by nominated jury.
- » Jury will be announced in our website and Social Media before final deadline.
- » The decision given by jury will be final.
